All schools are required by law, to keep on record details of children admitted as well as consent for other information held.

For information:

- The Academy is part of Oasis Community Learning (OCL). OCL collects and processes personal data. Personal data is any information that can lead to the identification of a specific individual.
- The EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) replaces the Data Protection Directive 95/46/EC and was designed to harmonize data privacy laws across Europe, to protect and empower all EU citizens data privacy and to reshape the way organizations across the region approach data privacy.
- The data we collect relates to various groups of data subjects (i.e. individuals) including parents, carers, students, siblings, our employees, volunteers and others involved in the life of the Academy. Data is collected for a variety of purposes including our legal and educational obligations, as well as statistical reporting. Some personal information we process is required to meet these obligations, whilst other information we process requires the specific consent of the individual and is optional; these circumstances are clearly indicated where relevant.
- The data is retained and managed in accordance with the OCL Data Protection and associated policies. More information about the processing of data with OCL can be found on the Academy and OCL websites within the Privacy Notice or can be obtained by contacting the Academy directly.
