- Engage lifelong learners with creative, dynamic and innovate teaching.
- Teach students about personal safety both online and in real life.
- Provide excellent teaching and an engaging curriculum to meet the needs of all children and provide you with information about their progress.
- Contact you regarding your child's attendance, punctuality, health or behaviour in school.
- Embrace the Oasis 9 Habits to support their moral and ethical compass, enabling them to grow up to be the best version of themselves that they can be.
- Embrace the Oasis 9 Habits to develop a positive attitude to one another, regardless of sex, race, culture, belief, values, age and need.
- Respect the confidentiality of information regarding each child.
- Provide information about our school, including relevant policies, meetings, workshops, and events by keeping our website up-to-date.
- Understand that staff and parents need to work together for a peaceful resolution to conflict.

As a parent/guardian I will:

- Ensure that my child attends every day, on time, dressed in full school uniform and with the correct equipment.
- Provide protective equipment that is highly recommended for specific sports and games. Should I not provide such equipment I understand the additional risk of injury involved.
- Work in co-operation with staff to resolve issues.
- Encourage my child to be enthusiastic about learning.
- Encourage my child to behave responsibly at home, at school or online.
- Attend meetings with my child's teacher and other staff.
- Regularly read information on the website, and check the important details or relevant policies, meetings and events.
- Understand that we need to work together for a peaceful resolution to conflict.
- Demonstrate tolerance and respect, setting a good example through my behaviour and speech.
- Manage my child's behaviour especially where it could otherwise lead to conflict or unsafe behaviour.
- Speak to a member of staff to help resolve any issues or concerns.
- Learn about the ethos behind the 9 habits and support that ethos at home.

As a student I will:

- Attend school regularly and on time, bringing with me all the things I need.
- Take care of school equipment.
- Try my best.
- Be polite at all times to students, adults and visitors.
- Do things the first time that I am asked.
- Always do my best.
- Keep my hands and feet to myself.
- Move calmly around the Academy.
- Look after our Academy and all the people in it.
- Wear school uniform and PE kit.
- Always have a go.
- Accept responsibility for the things that I do, both in real life and online.
- Tell a member of staff if I am worried, anxious or unhappy.
- Celebrate my successes, both in and out of school.
- Be a good role model.
- Learn & remember the 9 habits and practise them where I am making choices about my behaviour.
