

Oasis Academy Wintringham Policy Statement on Provider access

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the Academy for the purpose of giving them impartial information about the providers education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Students in Y7 – Y11 are entitled to:

- Find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point
- Access a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education through events which include; Assemblies, lunchtime drop in sessions and taster events
- Understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses, by the careers advisor developing network connections and working with them

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their current prospectus or any other relevant course literature in the Career office. The office is available to students during tutor time and lunch.


