Types of travel writing:

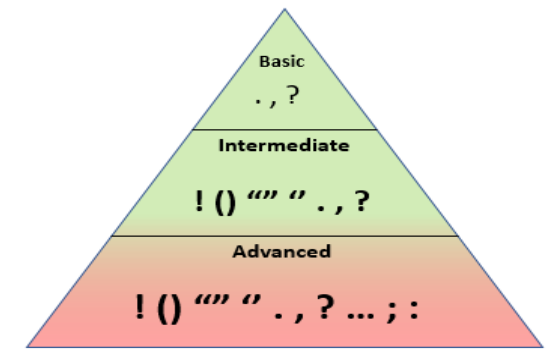
- Travel brochures

The senses

Using the senses to help the reader imagine the destination/ travel experience

METHODS used by the writer
Alliteration is when you use 2 or more words with the same starting letter or sound.
Facts are things that are proven to be true.
Rhetorical question is when you ask a question that doesn't need an answer
Repetition is when you repeat words or phrases during your writing.
Exaggeration is when you say something is better or worse than it really is
Statistics are facts as numbers
Tripling is a list of 3.
Simile is where you compare two things using 'like' or 'as'
Metaphor is where you compare two things saying something 'is' something else
