**Perfect tense**

The perfect tense is used to say what you did or have done. It is a completed action.  
To form the perfect tense you need

1- a part of avoir or être (to have)	To say what you did not do in the past add <b>ne...pas</b> around avoir. eg. Je <b>n'ai pas</b> ..
2- a past participle	

Verbs which take 'être'	
Devenir	to become
Revenir	to come back
Monter	to climb
Rester	to stay
Sortir	to go out
Venir	to come
Aller	to go
Naître	to be born
Descendre	to descend
Entrer	to enter
Retourner	to return
Tomber	to fall
Rentrer	to re-enter
Arriver	to arrive
Mourir	to die
Partir	to leave

In order to form a past participle you need to know what type of verb you are using. Remove the ending and add the following;		
-er verb	-ir verb	-re verb

**The imperfect tense**

The imperfect tense is used to describe an action in the past  
eg. c'était amusant → it was fun

**VERBS THAT TAKE ÊTRE MUST AGREE WITH THE SUBJECT**

**Asking questions**

The easiest way of asking a 'yes/no' question is to turn a statement into a question by making your voice go up at the end.

Tu as volé la jaconde- You stole the Mona Lisa.  
Tu as volé la jaconde? → Did you steal the Mona Lisa?

Another way of asking a 'yes/no' question is to put **Est-ce que** before a statement. You still need to make your voice go up at the end.

Est-ce que tu as volé la jaconde? → Did you steal the Mona Lisa?
