Information and support.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check that your child is doing his/her vocabulary learning task each week. Feel free to test them on spellings and meanings!</li> <li>• Check that your child has completed the written piece of home learning set too. This will typically be a past GCSE question or a 'Now try this' task set from the revision guide he/she has been given.</li> <li>• Ask your child if he/she has attended their 'revision' intervention session each week.</li> <li>• Encourage your child to follow a famous French footballer, sportsman or woman or actor on Twitter. Reading the 'tweets' will expose him/her to 'real' French and help to develop his/her translation skills.</li> <li>• Encourage your child to attend the intervention sessions timetabled for the holidays between now and May.</li> <li>• Keep reminding your child that a MFL GCSE is a such a worthwhile qualification which will set them apart from many other students at the moment.</li> </ul>
