<p>Information and support.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The new GCSE's are referred to as the 9-1 GCSE's. Take care when looking at various resources to check that they are aimed at these qualifications.</li> <li>• Encourage regular revision throughout the year to ensure your child is revisiting the work covered in school.</li> <li>• Encourage your child to attend the extra revision / intervention sessions.</li> <li>• Showing an interest in the subject, helping with homework, testing them. Students have to recall a lot of information in science and so talking through their knowledge and testing them can help embed this information as well as identify gaps.</li> <li>• Make sure they are using the revision guides and knowledge organisers that are provided.</li> <li>• Support your child in active revision, such as making flashcards, using the look-cover-write method of revision, completing past paper questions. Everyone revises in different ways – it is important that your child can identify the ways that help them the most.</li> </ul>
