Dear Parents & Carers

We have been advised by Public Health England that there has been two confirmed staff cases of COVID-19 within Oasis Academy Wintringham. As you know, we have put extensive measures in place to ensure that our students and staff are as safe as possible. The Department for Education have confirmed that because we have followed our strict protocols that there is no action to be taken at this time as nobody has been in close contact with either of these members of staff. These cases are isolated and the staff are in different teams in the academy. One of the members of staff has been isolating since Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> November so has not been in school for over a week. Please don't be alarmed, but it is a reminder that we all need to remain vigilant, both in school and in the wider community.

We are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with Public Health England. This letter is to inform you of the current situation and provide advice on how to support your child; please be assured that we will keep in regular contact.

Please see below, the direct advice and communication from Public Health England:

We know that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness, but we all have a responsibility to ensure that we do all that we can to reduce transmission to others.

**The school remains open to students in all year groups** and, providing your child remains well, they can continue to attend school as normal. We will keep this under review.

### **What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19**

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, you should organise for your child to be tested via the NHS online portal or by calling 119. Your household should isolate until you receive the test results giving the all clear.

### **Symptoms of COVID 19**

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

Do continue to:


- wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds
