Dear Parent/Guardian

As we approach the half-term break, I wanted to provide you with some key updates and make you aware of a big change that will be taking place after half-term which the students have been made aware of by their form tutor.

School Uniform

As an Academy, we will be reverting back to 'normal' for school uniform, this is the next stage of us moving out of the pandemic following the Government's move to Plan A. Therefore, this means:

- Students will come to school every day in their school uniform and will no longer be allowed to come in their PE kit (even when they have PE or extra-curricular activities).
- Coats will be removed at the door as students enter the Academy and will not be allowed to be worn in the building, other than at break and lunchtimes (unless it is very cold).
- Plain black jumpers or Academy jumpers (which can be purchased from the uniform shop), can be worn under blazers until Easter.
- Scarves can no longer be worn as they are considered outdoor wear.

Our other uniform rules, such as no hoodies on site and that students must wear school shoes and not trainers, will be strictly followed using our Academy localised behaviour policy. All policies and a copy of our uniform list can be found on our school website.

PE KIT

- PE kit must be brought in bags.
- Students should avoid bringing any valuables with them.
- Students will be expected to change in the changing rooms at the start and end of lessons.
- Any student that fails to bring their PE kit will be expected to borrow ours for that lesson.
- It is important that all PE kit is named.
- All jewellery is to be removed during PE lessons.

End of Year trips for all students


