Dear Parent/Guardian



Firstly, I would like to share with you that Year 7 have made an excellent start to their secondary school journey. It really has been wonderful to see so many smiley faces, to see the students making new friends and embracing new challenges and experiences. I thank them for their efforts so far and encourage them to continue with this positive start at Oasis Academy Wintringham.

I am writing to invite you to our 'Virtual Y7 Settling in Evening', which is being held on Wednesday 20th October, 2021, between 4.00pm and 6.30pm, this is an opportunity for you to meet with your child's form tutor, albeit virtually. This letter has also been sent to your email account for ease of clicking on the links below.

Our parents' evenings are now held through an online service called 'SchoolCloud'. Booking and managing appointments is very intuitive as are the video meetings with tutors and keyworkers on the evening itself. Parents/carers will be seen strictly in appointment order and are limited to 5-minute slots, after which the platform will automatically end the appointment. If there is a need for a longer conversation, then a follow up appointment should be made at another time. Appointments are made on a first-come first-served basis.

This parents' evening will give you the opportunity to meet your child's form tutor. Some of you may also have an appointment made for you to speak with the Head of Year, Year Manager, Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator or Transition Mentor. I must highlight that academic progress will not be discussed by your child's form tutor as it is still very early on in the new term. Instead, tutors will talk to you about how your child has settled in, and how they are contributing to tutor time and personal development.


