Vaccination Online Consent Form – Year 8 Pupils Only

During June and July, the School Nursing Service will be visiting your child's school to offer the Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccination.

This vaccine is a course of 2 doses given 6-24 months apart and helps protect against cancers caused by HPV, including cervical, penile and anal cancers as well as some mouth and throat (head and neck) cancers.

Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)

What is HPV?

A common group of viruses that affect your skin and mucous linings of the body.

HPV can cause...

Genital warts, cancer of the cervix, anus, penis and some mouth and throat cancers.

How is it spread?

It can be transmitted by any skin-to-skin contact in the genital and oral areas

Possible Common Side effects of the vaccine

- Pain and swelling around injection site
- Fever
- Nausea
- Headache
