### Vaccination Online Consent Form - Year 8 Pupils Only

Between February half term and the Easter holidays, the School Nursing Service will be visiting your child's school to offer the Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccination.

This vaccine is a course of 2 doses given 6-12 months apart and helps protect against cancers caused by HPV, including cervical, penile and anal cancers as well as some mouth and throat (head and neck) cancers.

# **Vaccination Information**

## **Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)**

### What is HPV?

A common group of viruses that affect your skin and mucous linings of the body.

HPV can cause...

Genital warts, cancer of the cervix, anus, penis and some mouth and throat cancers.

How is HPV spread?

It can be transmitted by any skin-to-skin contact in the genital and oral areas

Possible Common Side effects of the HPV vaccine

Vaccination is a course of 2 doses 6-12 months apart.

- Pain and swelling around injection site
- Fever
- Nausea
- Headache
