Dear Parents/Carers,

I wanted to write and wish all of our Year 11 students the very best of luck as their first full week of formal written exams begins next week. They have made a fantastic start in their art, photography, health and social care and sport exams and we are incredibly proud of how they are conducting themselves and how keen they are to do well.

We fully appreciate that this is a stressful time for young people and wanted to reassure you that we are doing all we can to support your son/daughter during the exam period. We continue to offer intervention sessions throughout this time and also amend our timetable each day to ensure Year 11 receive additional teaching for exams they have coming up, as they complete other subjects. This approach has proven highly successful and also provides real reassurance for students because each and every hour they attend school they are revising and we are helping them prepare. Mrs Dowson is also putting the final touches to the May half term revision schedule which, once again, offers further opportunities for guided revision. We are incredibly grateful to our staff for giving up their holiday to offer this.

The final school day for Year 11 will be Monday 17th June and students will arrive at normal time and leave at 11am. They must attend each day up to this date, for the full day, so that we can support them with their exam preparation. It is important that they also arrive each day in full uniform and bring all of their equipment, including their iPad. The last day is always incredibly enjoyable with students wearing fancy dress, enjoying mocktails, a final assembly and year group photo, as well as the chance to say farewell to staff. This year, after consulting our Prom Committee, we will also be having a photobooth and two balloon arches for them to take photographs with their friends. They have also asked for the return of waffles from our canteen and sausage buns! They will be able to use their lunch account to pay for this and it is important that that they use their credit between now and the last day because we are unable to refund this.

We know that shirt signing is something that students are keen to participate in and we will confirm a day with them when this is best to take place. We have to be mindful that they cannot attend an exam with any writing on their clothing so the timing of this is important.

To ensure that your child is able to enjoy these experiences they must attend all exams, remain in the Academy completing their bespoke timetable and conduct themselves well during the exam period. We also established back in December that they needed to achieve a score of 0 when their negative and positive behaviour points were combined. We have given them as many opportunities as possible to earn positive points and continue to do so as they attend their exams and intervention during this period. We will continue monitoring their scores and will notify you on Friday 14th June if your child has not met this threshold and therefore cannot attend the last day or Prom.
