End of Year Trips Wednesday 23 July 2025

To mark the end of another school year we are running trips to Yorkshire Wildlife Park, Flamingo Land and Ninja Warrior with lunch at Meadowhall. To be eligible students must have had a good overall standard of behaviour throughout the year. This includes having not been suspended and not been in Internal Exclusion from Easter, which all students were informed of via assembly and tutor during the first week back. We have also launched a new attendance focus and students need attendance of 92%, again from the Easter break.

The details and cost of each trip is as follows:

Ninja Warrior (Years 7-10) £33

Flamingo Land (Years 7-10) £48

Yorkshire Wildlife Park (Years 7-9) £21

The trips will go live on the MCAS app at 16:30 on Friday 23 May and are on a first come, first served basis. Places are limited and have been shared equally between the year groups. Any monies paid will go towards the transport cost and the event entry. Please be aware there can be no refund of any kind, for any reason, as once we have paid the supplier we cannot get the money back. Students' behaviour between booking and the trip leaving must be of a good standard. If students are in Internal Exclusion or suspended in this period, they will not be allowed to attend.

Payments for the trip can only be accepted by MCAS online. If you have not got an existing MCAS log-in, please contact the Academy.

The deadline for payments is Friday 20 June. Payment after this date may not be accepted because we are invoiced and pay in advance for park tickets and transport costs. Any monies paid will be non-refundable unless the trip is full, and someone

Ninja Warrior

The trip will leave the Academy at 09:00 and the students will have a 2-hour session on the Ninja training course. When they have finished they will be taken to Meadowhall to get lunch before heading home. We expect to arrive back around 16:00. Students will need additional spending money on the day but may take a pack up for lunch if they wish. If your child is eligible for free school meals the Academy will provide a packed lunch for them. Flamingo land

The trip will leave the Academy at 07:30 and the students will have about 6 hours in Flamingo Land. They will be free to explore the park and rides in small groups. We expect to arrive back around 19:00. Students will need additional spending money on the day but may take a pack up for lunch if they wish. Yorkshire Wildlife Park

The trip will leave the Academy at 08:45 and the students will be able to explore the park in small groups. We expect to arrive back around 15:30. Due to the park restrictions, students must stay with their group and a member of staff for the day. It is recommended that students bring a packed lunch as opportunities to purchase food in the park are limited. If your child is eligible for free school meals the Academy will provide a packed lunch for them.
