I am writing to inform you of an important update to our school's mobile phone policy. From the 8<sup>th</sup> December, Year 7 students will no longer be required to hand in their mobile phones at the start of the school day.

This change reflects our commitment to fostering trust and responsibility among students, while continuing to maintain a safe and focused learning environment. We believe that allowing students to manage their own devices helps prepare them for real-world expectations and encourages responsible digital behaviour.

Please note:

- Phones must remain switched off and out of sight during lessons and in corridors.
- Any misuse of mobile phones will result in sanctions in line with our behaviour policy.

We will closely monitor the impact of this change over the coming weeks. If we find that it negatively affects learning or behaviour, we will revert to the previous system of handing phones in.
