MyChildAtSchool (MCAS) is an online portal for parents that enables you to view your child's performance and other information in real time, via the website or mobile app.

This facility allows access to your child's Attendance, Assessment and Behaviour for up-to-date information without having to wait for termly reports. You are also able to view your child's teachers and their weekly timetable.

The portal also provides general useful information about the Academy such as the Academic calendar and Academy announcements. In addition, it has a messaging feature to support communication with the Academy.

Parents can also view the student and contact details held on our records for your child and advise us of any important changes, e.g. change of address or contact numbers. It is important that our information is kept up to date should we need to make contact with you.

Multiple students: If you have more than one child at the Academy, you are able to click on the name of the student next to their photograph and it will give you the option to select other students associated with the user. Click on the photograph or the text to change the views allowing information to be viewed with just one login.

MCAS is also used to communicate Parents evening information enabling parents to book their own appointment slots with teachers. Booked appointments will appear in time order and can be printed off for your information.

To access MCAS, simply visit www.mychildatschool.com and sign up using your supplied details:

Nut-Free Academy

Please note that we are a nut-free zone to ensure the safety of our young people, staff and visitors.



Oasis Academy Wintringham aims to be a nut-free Academy, although we recognise it is impossible to provide an absolute guarantee that nuts will not be brought onto the premises.

The Academy aims to protect our students who have allergies that can be really severe, leading to Anaphylaxis, which can be life-threatening. So we are asking all members of our Academy community for their help in minimising the risk, to these students, by not sending or bringing in the following:

- Any nuts or nut products
- Chocolate spread (e.g. Nutella)
- Granola bars containing nuts
- Sesame seed rolls
- Sauces like satay
- Sweets, biscuits, cakes and chocolate containing nut products

This list is not exhaustive, so please check packaging carefully. We appreciate this is an additional thing to do, but know you recognise the importance of it.
